## Practical information on submission evaluation

The main objective of this document is to describe the evaluation procedure to be followed for all non-ISBI 2021 submissions received by February 28th, 2021, and all ISBI 2021 submissions received by March 1st, 2021. All submissions received after March 1st, 2021, will continue being evaluated monthly and will be processed after the ISBI 2021 challenge workshop scheduled on April 13th, 2021.

## Specific schedule for non-ISBI 2021 submissions

February 28th, 2021 – The deadline for submitting results

March 1st, 2021 – Consistency checking of all received submissions

March 1st, 2021 - Sending out of the information on inconsistent submissions

March 8th, 2021 – The deadline for resubmitting inconsistent results

March 9th-13th, 2021 – Evaluation of all consistent submissions

March 14th, 2021 – Sending out of scores and particular ranks achieved

March 14th, 2021 – Release of updated CSB and CTB leaderboards, provided there is a change compared to the leaderboards posted before March 1st, 2021

## Specific schedule for ISBI 2021 submissions (primary and secondary tracks)

March 1st, 2021 – The deadline for submitting results

March 2nd-3rd, 2021 – Consistency checking of all received submissions

March 3rd, 2021 – Sending out of the information on inconsistent submissions

March 8th, 2021 – The deadline for resubmitting inconsistent results

March 9th-April 12th, 2021 – Evaluation and analysis of all consistent submissions

April 13th, 2021 - Sending out of scores and particular ranks achieved

April 13th, 2021 – Release of updated CSB and CTB leaderboards

## FTP accounts

All FTP accounts will be first temporarily disabled at 23:59 on March 1st, 2021, while allowing all data transfers in progress to be completed, next purposely enabled for resubmitting possibly inconsistent results by March 8th, 2021, and finally fully enabled from March 15th, 2021.
